COSMETOLOGY		
<b>PRINCIPLES OF COSMETOLOGY</b>	This one-year course is designed to introduce the basic principles of cosmetology. Students learn the role of safety in serving the public and familiarizing themselves with the tools and equipment used in the cosmetology field. Activities provide students with the opportunity to observe hair, nail, and skin care processes. Instructional practices incorporate integration of diversity awareness including appreciation of all cultures and their important contributions to society.	<b>Grades: 10</b> <b>Prerequisite: Good attendance is mandatory. Strong math, reading and science skills are necessary.</b> <b>Students must be willing to learn challenging tasks and be able to work with all types of people.</b>

<p><b>COSMETOLOGY I</b></p>	<p>This one-year course is designed to provide training in the theory and practice of cosmetology. Students will receive classroom instruction and be provided with demonstration of cosmetology methods. They will be given laboratory practice in professional ethics, sanitation, human anatomy, skin care, hair care, nail care, and cosmetic product use. First-year students must complete a <b>minimum</b> of 160 hours of instruction before they are permitted to practice on a client in the laboratory. Upon completion of the junior year of cosmetology instruction and practice, students will advance to Cosmetology II. Students are required to provide a copy of their Social Security card when enrolling (9<sup>th</sup> grade) in Cosmetology. Students are responsible to purchase their own uniforms. <b>Lab fees are due in full upon entering the junior and senior year and no payment plans are available.</b> This course will fulfill six elective credits required for high school graduation. <b>See the Appendix for the Instructional Fee List.</b></p>	<p><b>Grades: 11</b>  <b>Prerequisite:</b>  <b>Principles of Cosmetology</b>  <b>Good attendance is mandatory. Strong math, reading and science skills are necessary.</b>  <b>Students must be willing to learn challenging tasks and be able to work with all types of people.</b>  <b>Credits: 6</b></p>
<p><b>COSMETOLOGY II</b></p>	<p>This one-year course is designed to provide training in the theory and practice of cosmetology. Students receive classroom instruction and demonstration of cosmetology methods. Instruction is given in professional ethics, sanitation, human anatomy, skin care, hair care, nail care, and cosmetic use. Emphasis is also placed on employability skills and salon management. Upon the completion of 1600 hours, successful passing of the Practical Exam (proctored at SECTA or at a private cosmetology school) and at the age of 18, students can apply to the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology to take the written portion of Cosmetology Licensure Examination. When students have successfully passed the written test, they are then issued a Nevada State Board of Cosmetology Master Cosmetology License. Students are responsible to purchase their own uniforms and name tag. <b>Lab fees are due in full upon entering the junior and senior year and no payment plans are available.</b> This course will fulfill six of the elective credits required for high school graduation. <b>See the Appendix for the Instructional Fee List.</b></p>	<p><b>Grades: 12</b>  <b>Prerequisite:</b>  <b>Cosmetology 1</b>  <b>Good attendance is mandatory.
